## WHAT IS A *Youth Ambassador Team?*

In today's globalised world, working in teams is not only an essential skill, it is also a fantastic way to share workload, develop ideas with different perspectives and receive support and encouragement.

Our teams are generally made up of around five young people from the same school or community who are committed to sharing the story of India's most impoverished people and developing their knowledge and skills in leadership and social justice in a modern world.

## WHAT IS A YOUTH AMBASSADOR *Team Member* AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

A team member is a young person who has demonstrated a clear passion for social justice, perseverance in carrying out projects and a strong ability to work with others.

If you are selected as a Team Member, you will:

- Align your skills with your passions by collaborating with a team to raise funds and awareness for India's outcasts
- Develop your communication and organisation skills with the support of a team leader and DFN mentor
- Learn more about India, the Jogini practice and how you can help
- Gain experience and knowledge about working in a mission/social justice context
- Work with your team to help DFN AU & NZ on their campaign ideas and help create social media fundraising and awareness campaigns
- Attend conferences (subject to location) to speak to your local community about the work of DFN in India.
- Be a support and encouragement to the members of your team

## WHAT IS A YOUTH AMBASSADOR *Team Leader* AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

A team leader is a young person selected by DFN to lead a Youth Ambassador Team. They have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities including time management, interpersonal skills, creative and innovative thinking and a clear passion for social justice.

If you are selected as a Team Leader, you will experience all of the above PLUS:

- Develop your leadership abilities in practical ways with the support of a DFN mentor
- Delegate tasks and activities to your team based on their strengths and interests
- Create a positive environment, provide support and encouragement to your team
- Work with us on our campaigns
- Regularly communicate with your DFN mentor
